In other action, the Board:



- Approved the purchase PowerSchool support and maintenance for the period March 26, 2019 through March 25, 2020, from PowerSchool Group LLC of Folsom, CA, for \$5.20 per active student count, which is estimated to equate to a total cost of \$36,498.80.
- Approved the purchase of two lathes for the WTC Precision Machining Technology program in a total amount not to exceed \$53,000, by selection of a vendor through a sealed bid process.
- Adopted a Board Resolution in support of participation in The Reading Now Network.
